With only virtual sessions being allowed, the group dispersed and moved through the pandemic. Three cancelled shows and a lot of time later, we were finally able to take to the stage again.

In December 2021 the students from the 'Expressive Arts Asdan Award' created a show called 'The Year That Wasn't'. We have wanted to aim for a big production for a few years and we now feel it is time to bring it to the stage. Our 2024 Christmas Show will be 'The Nutcracker'. The show will consist of script, dancing, singing, poetry, and a massive collection of costumes. This is one not to be missed!
